Directions: Evergreen Memorial Park is located halfway between Evergreen and Conifer.

From I-70 West: at El Rancho go eight (8) miles to Evergreen, turn right (south) onto Hwy. 73 at the stoplight below Evergreen Lake. Follow Hwy. 73 for four (4) miles and turn left (east) onto No. Turkey Creek Rd. The Park entrance will be the first turn to the right past the Conference Baptist Church.

From Hwy. 285: No. Turkey Creek Rd. is the second major right hand turn after entering the mountains (about eight miles from the C-470 exit). Turn right off Hwy. 285 onto No. Turkey Creek Rd. Follow No. Turkey Creek Rd. 5-1/2 miles. The Park entrance will be the first left hand turn beyond the Park office facility, which is across the street from Marshdale Elementary School.

For those who will not enjoy a twisting road, or if it is snowing heavily, continue on Hwy. 285 to Conifer (about seven miles past No. Turkey Creek Rd.), turn right (north) and follow Hwy. 73 for four miles to No. Turkey Creek Rd. Turn right on No Turkey Creek Rd. and go 1/2 mile.

Evergreen Pet Cemetery offers complete burial and/or cremation services. Arrangements can be made as simple or as elaborate as you wish. You are free to choose those services which suitably express that unique relationship between you and your pet.

Evergreen Pet Cemetery will give special attention and care to the burial and/or cremation of your special animal friend and pet. Whatever type pet you have, large or small, we stand ready to meet your pet's special needs.

Caskets

Evergreen Pet Cemetery offers a wide variety of custom made pet caskets. The prices vary according to the size and design of the casket desired. Caskets are made from a variety of materials and come lined and unlined. Evergreen Pet Cemetery also offers concrete and fiberglass vaults. However, your pet does not have to be buried in a casket or vault. See "Burials".

Memorials

Pet memorial markers are custom made from bronze and/or granite. Inscriptions and the likeness of your pet, including photos, can be included on the marker. A temporary marker will be placed on each grave at the time of burial.

water all new or replaced sod, there is no assurance that water, either in quality or quantity, is available to prevent native grasses from turning brown. In fact, the natural environment is quite arid and not accustomed to irrigation, so tree selection should be determined by this fact.

Snow Removal

Although the Park shall use best efforts to plow snow promptly, no guarantee is extended that the roads will be passable at all times. Inquiries as to access in the Park may be made with the Park Superintendent.

These Rules and Regulations have been adopted by the Board of Directors of Evergreen Memorial Park, Inc. to give order and direction to a place of beauty, and may be changed at any time by board action.

The use of tiles, bricks, and gravel, crushed rock, oyster shell, cinders, or other materials on any lot in the Park is strictly forbidden. Any of these used may be removed by the Park without notice to the lot Interment Rights owner.

Temporary markers or ornaments shall not be used, except as set by the Park.

Marble markers or monuments shall not be allowed, except by special permission from the Park Superintendent.

All markers and monuments in the Perpetual Care and 10 Year Renewable areas shall be flat bronze memorials, unless approved by the Park Superintendent in writing. All primary monuments in Garden of the Cross Upright shall be upright.

DESIGN, FINISH AND WORKMANSHIP: The Park Superintendent shall have the power to reject any plan or design for any memorial which on account of size, design, inscription, or kind or quality of stone, in his opinion, is unsuited to the lot on which it is to be placed.

Foundations

Applications for foundations shall be made by the burial space owner of record or his representative at the Park Superintendent's office. All charges for the foundation shall be paid at the time the application is made. In addition, no monument or marker shall be delivered to the Park until these charges have been paid. No monument or marker shall be delivered to the Park, or set, until all outstanding debts owed to the Park have been paid. No foundations will be set from November 1st to May 1st or during freezing weather.

All markers or monuments bought at places other than at the Park will be subject to a charge for foundation, setting and perpetual care. These charges will be identical with those placed on the cost of the markers purchased from the Park. Perpetual care will be 10% of the total cost of the bronze and foundation.

All markers set by the company that sold the marker will have to do so according to the rules governing marker placement for each individual Garden. The space that the marker is to be placed will be laid out by the Park Superintendent. There will be a charge assessed by the Superintendent for either locating and/or inspecting the set marker with a minimum charge of one hour.

CONTRACTORS OR SUBCONTRACTORS: Evergreen Pet Cemetery reserves the right to examine any contractor or subcontractor to insure sufficient skills and equipment to perform stated tasks at a level of efficiency acceptable to the Park. A \$2,000 bond issued in favor of Evergreen Memorial Park must be furnished to cover any damage that might be caused by the said contractor. In addition, a 10% endowment care deposit will be required before the marker will be allowed.

Water

Hydrant water is for irrigation and no guarantee is made as to potability. Therefore, there are no drinking water provisions in the Park. Although the Park will attempt to

Burials

Burials may be done either with or without a casket. Some chose to wrap the pet in a blanket.

Burials can be in one of three areas:

1. 10-Year Renewable Contract Area;
2. Perpetual Care lot, where a flush marker can be placed;
3. Perpetual Care Upright, where an upright memorial marker can be placed.
4. Horse area;
 - a. Perpetual Care section;
Flat markers may be placed on graves in this section.
 - b. Pasture;
Horses may be placed in the pasture area, but the graves cannot be marked or visited.

Cremation

Cremation can be a very dignified process. Evergreen Pet Cemetery has a variety of special urns and vaults available if you wish to take the cremains home with you as a beautiful and everlasting memorial, or the cremains can be buried in a marked plot.

Special Arrangements

Evergreen Pet Cemetery has pick-up service available from your home or veterinarian's office, at a nominal fee determined by distance.

Our staff will be happy to meet with you and make all arrangements that you may desire in order to relieve any additional grief or distress at this trying time.

All fees shall be paid in full at the time services are requested and arrangements are completed. Checks, cash, Visa, MasterCard or Discover will be accepted.

It is our hope that by providing a beautiful final resting place for your pet at Evergreen Pet Cemetery we may inspire in others love and kindness for God's creatures.

Pre-Need

What would you do if your dear pet died tomorrow? You don't want to think about it, but the day will come ... and if you've continually closed your mind to that cruel possibility, then that day will be all the more difficult.

Convenient time payments ahead of time can be arranged so that all fees are paid when the time of need arrives.

Over the years, pet owners will find a tangible means of expressing their loss and memorializing their love through burial in Evergreen Pet Cemetery. "We can bury your pet's remains, but we can never bury your memories."

Grave Space Lots

If you select a grave space at Evergreen Pet Cemetery, you will be granted an easement for burial and memorialization of your pet. You will not own the real property, but can use the space for burial purposes subject to the rules and regulations of the Pet Cemetery.

Decoration of Lots

Live flowers may not be planted or cultivated on any grave at any time.

Artificial or fresh cut flowers may be placed in a temporary vase at any time, however they will be discarded when withered, faded, broken or anything of similar nature. The same will apply to flowers placed in vases attached to bronze memorials. All flowers will be removed from vases at the time that the Park is mowed regardless of their condition. Sprays and wreaths made from fresh cut or artificial flowers will be allowed, but they will be removed at periodic times of maintenance, or if in the Park Superintendent's opinion, they become unsightly or detrimental or are blown off the graves.

The placing of boxes, shells, stones, boulders, toys, metal designs, ornaments, glass, urns, fences, wood or metal cases and similar articles upon lots, shall not be allowed. The placing of chairs or benches shall only be done with the approval of the Park Superintendent.

If placement of flower arrangements or grave blankets, tree maintenance, or other special services are requested by a family, a service fee will be charged by the Park.

LIABILITY TO DECORATIONS: The Cemetery shall not be held liable for lost, misplaced or broken flower vases, or for damage or misplacement by the elements, thieves, vandals or by causes beyond its control. The Park reserves the right to regulate the method of decorating lots and the right to remove any decoration so that a uniform beauty may be maintained.

TREES: Trees may be planted by individuals in any area that has been approved by the Park Superintendent. Permission and location of the tree must be given by the Superintendent before a tree can be planted.

The Park will not be held responsible for damage done by wild life, stock animals, or disease. The Park reserves the right to remove any tree that does not maintain the Park's natural beauty. Although they will use best efforts to water and tend trees and shrubs, they will not be responsible for the replacement of trees or shrubs that die for whatever reason.

Monuments and Markers

All monuments and markers in the Park must be of a design and quality approved by the Park.

No memorial or grave marker will be allowed on any burial space until the space has been fully paid for and the Deed for Interment Rights has been transferred to the purchaser. All transfer records are kept in the office at the Park, and no such transfers will be recognized excepting those shown on the books of the Pet Cemetery.

No interment rights owner shall erect or place or cause to be erected or placed, on any lot in the Park, any memorial in respect of which the Park Superintendent disapproves.

In the upright marker areas, the area of the face of the memorial shall not exceed twenty percent (20%) of the area of the lot. The length of the base of the memorial shall not exceed seventy-five percent (75%) of the width of the lot. The width of the base of the memorial shall not exceed twenty percent (20%) of the length of the lot. Any stone marker or memorial shall have a thickness of at least five inches.

Grave markers shall be of one piece of approved bronze or granite and shall not exceed the size of the grave space allowing for a four-inch border of grass on the grave.

The bottom surface of all monuments or markers shall be level and true.

While the Park will exercise due care to protect raised lettering, carving or ornaments on any memorial or other structure on any lot in the Park, it disclaims responsibility for any injury thereto.

No coping, curbing, hedging, grave mounds, borders, enclosures of any kind, or walks of any kind shall be allowed to be built or placed on any lot in the Park. The Park reserves the right to remove the same without recourse, if so planted, erected or placed.
